

# **HOW TO PLAY**

The aim of Baccarat 27 is to place a wager on the hand that you think will have a point total of nine, or the closest to nine. You may place a wager on any of the following betting options:

Player
Banker
Tie

Player Pair
Banker Pair
B-27 (when offered)

Once all wagers have been placed and dealer announces "NO MORE BETS", the Dealer will deal the initial two cards alternatively to the Player and Banker. Cards are dealt according to the Tableau (Table of Play), with a minimum of two cards and a maximum of three cards dealt to each the Player and Banker hands. No optional cards may be drawn to eith

#### **PLAYER**

Winning bets on the Player hand are paid at the odds of 1 to 1

#### **BANKER**

When Banker wins with a total of 2, odds of 2 to 1 (200%) are paid on all winning Banker bets.

When Banker wins with a total of 7, odds of 1 to 2 (50%) are paid on all winning Banker bets.

When Banker wins with any other totals, odds of 1 to 1 (Even Mo

#### TIF

If you think that both hands will have the same total, a winning wager on Tie will be paid at the odds of 8 to 1.


#### PLAYER PAIR or BANKER PAIR

A wager on the Player and Banker Pair bets will win if the first two cards dealt to each corresponding hand are the same. Winning Pair bets are paid at the odds of 11 to 1.

### B-27 (when offered)

A side wager wherein the player can win at odds of 8 to 1 when Banker wins on either a total of 2 points or a total of 7 points.

You may place a Tie or Pair or B-27 wager without having placed a wager on Player or Banker, or you can place a multiple number of wagers on the same hand.



# HAND TOTALS


Tens, Picture Cards and multiples of 10 count as zero. When the card total is 10 or greater, the second digit determines the value of the hand.

A 'Natural' is when the first two cards dealt to either the Player or Banker equal 8 or 9.

• Examples are 7+2=9, 6+2=8, 9+9=8, K+9=9

When a 'Natural' is drawn to either hand, no further cards are dealt. After the initial two cards have been dealt to each, if required, the Dealer will draw additional cards according to the Table of Play.

# **EXAMPLE OF HANDS:**



\*Player wins 7 over 3

Point Value of Player's First Two Cards	Player	Point Value of Banker's First Two Cards	Banker
0	Draw a third card	0 1 2	Draw a third card
2		3	Stands when the Player's third card is 8
3		4	Stands when the Player's third card is 1, 8, 9, 10
5		5	Stands when the Player's third card is 1, 2, 3, 8, 9, 10
6 7	Always Stands	6	Banker always draws a 3rd card when player's 3rd card is 6, 7
		7	No more cards
8 9	Natural, no more cards	8 9	Natural, no more cards

If either the Player or the Banker achieves a total of 8 or 9 on the initial deal (known as a "Natural"), no further cards are drawn.

Chips can be bought at any gaming table or cashier using Peso; selected gaming tables will accept HKD. Other currencies can be changed at the cashier only.
